

Here's The Right Way To Build A Chicken Coop!

If you have a hammer and nails or a good drill, and a weekend afternoon, you can build your own [chicken](#) coop, spending less than the price of a new one or even for free.

Craigslist and local retail outlets are often a good source of used pallets, empty wooden crates and other scrap wood that you can get for free or at a minimal cost. You just need to know how to do it!

Chicken wire can be affordably sourced at a local hardware or farm supply store, along with a few hinges and a lock. With an afternoon of labor you can have a secure chicken coop for a handful of laying hens.

1.5 Chickens only sleep in coop and roost (long fence post or pole) so you can go inside to capture it, if bird

1. Build up an arch and add extra stone into the arch to ensure waterproofing.
2. A stone is using for a raised base.
3. Use of plaster, because at night no glass piece, heated up.

Don't want your wire or a rod to protrude from inside of your pen?

Position plates to hide bands if they aren't under rating.

- 1) Weld rod(s) on top of 4 corner blocks will work.
- 2) Take excess rod(s) around corner.
- 3) Place in corner of pen.
- 4) 1st division too far from corner.
- 5) Second corner for pen goes here.

- 1) Build a solid bench in your corner beds for making the changing large quantities of material like foam, clay, paper, and old leaves material.
