## Why Every Family Needs This Card

What happens when a disaster closes schools, jams up the roads, or triggers a sudden evacuation order?

Phones die. Batteries fail. Vehicles get separated. Children panic. And when families lose contact under pressure, even simple decisions can become dangerous.

This wallet-sized Family Emergency Card gives every member of your household a written reunification plan they can carry all times. It gives your family a simple way to regroup, follow the same instructions, and avoid confusion when communication breaks down.

A small card may not look like much. But in a real emergency, a clear written plan can make all the difference.

## How to Make Your Family Emergency Card

### 1. Cut it out

Carefully cut along the outer edge of the card.

### 2. Fill it out

Write in your family's meeting points, emergency contact, medications, and local resource.

### 3. Fold and laminate it

Fold the card in half, then laminate it for added durability.

### 4. Give one to every family member

Make sure each family member carries one in a wallet, purse, vehicle, or go-bag.
